Following your notification received 23/02/2011 I confirm that the details of the waste operation you describe have been placed on our public register of exempt waste operations. If the details above are incorrect, please contact us on 08708 506 506.

The operation will only continue to be exempt if it meets the criteria set out in schedules 2 and 3 of the above regulations and does not endanger human health or involve processes which could harm the environment. In particular, it should not:

- pose a risk to water, air, soil, plants or animals
- cause nuisance through noise or odours
- adversely affect the countryside or places of special interest

You are required to keep a record of the quantity, nature, origin, destination and treatment method of all waste disposed of or recovered in the course of your exempt waste operation. These records must be kept for at least two years. They must also be made available to us on request. If your exemption is for Paragraph 9 or 19 and uses less than 2,500 cubic metres of waste, you do not need to do this.



If you fail to comply with the requirements of the exemption, we can remove your activity from the public register and bring criminal proceedings against you.

If the operation changes, or if you undertake any other operation involving the recovery or disposal of waste, please contact us on 08708 506 506.

Please note that if you have renewed a Paragraph 9, 10 or 19 exemption then your registration will only be valid until the 30 September 2011. This is because, when the Environmental Permitting (England and Wates) Regulations 2010 came into force in April 2010, a limited period was allowed for existing exemptions to continue to be used. These exemptions cannot be used from the 1 October 2011. We will not make any pro-rata refund of your registration fee for the reduced registration period.

If you need a permit in order to carry on your waste operation after that date, then you must have made an application for the relevant environmental permit on or before the 30th September 2011. You will then be able to continue operating under the exemption until your permit is determined or, if the application is refused until any appeal is determined.
